PURPOSE

The purpose of this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") is to inform users of our Site of the following:

- 1. The personal data we will collect.
- 2. Use of collected data.
- 3. Who has access to the data collected.
- 4. The rights of Site users.
- 5. The Site's cookie policy.

GDPR

For users in the European Union, we adhere to the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, known as the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"). For users in the United Kingdom, we adhere to the GDPR as enshrined in the Data Protection Act 2018.

We have not appointed a Data Protection Officer as we do not fall within the categories of controllers and processors required to appoint a Data Protection Officer under Article 37 of the GDPR.

CONSENT

By using our Site users agree that they consent to the conditions set out in this Privacy Policy.

LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

We collect and process personal data about users in the EU and the UK only when we have a legal basis for doing so under Article 6 of the GDPR. In instances where users outside the EU or UK visit our Site, we apply the data processing regulations applicable to the UK.

We reply on the following legal basis to collect and process the personal data of users in the EU:

- 1. Processing of user personal data is necessary for us or a third party to pursue legitimate interest. Our legitimate interest is not overridden by the interests of fundamental rights and freedoms of users. Our legitimate interests are due diligence, compliance and communication.
- 2. Processing of user personal data is necessary for us to take, at the request of a user, steps before entering a contract or for the performance of a contract to which a user is a party. If a user does not provide the personal data necessary to perform a contract, then no contract is entered into.

PERSONAL DATA WE COLLECT

We only collect data that helps us to achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.



DATA COLLECTED IN A NON-AUTOMATIC WAY

We may also collect the following data when you perform certain functions on our Site:

- 1. First and last name.
- 2. Email address.
- 3. Telephone number.

This data may be collected using the contact form a user completes on our website.

HOW WE USE PERSONAL DATA

Data collected on our Site will only be used for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy or indicated on the relevant pages of our Site. We will not use your data beyond what we disclose in this Privacy Policy.

The data we collect when the user performs certain functions may be used for the purpose of communication.

WHO WE SHARE PERSONAL DATA WITH

User personal data is used by our employees for the purpose of communication with the user.

OTHER DISCLOSURES

We will not sell or share your data with third parties, except in the following cases:

- 1. If the law requires it.
- 2. If it is required for any legal proceeding.
- 3. To prove or protect our legal rights.

If you follow links from our Site to another site, please note that we are not responsible for and have no control over their privacy policies and practices.

HOW LONG WE STORE PERSONAL DATA

User data will be stored until the purpose the data was collected for has been achieved. You will be notified if your data is kept for longer than this period.

HOW WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA

All data is only accessible to our employees. Our employees are bound by strict confidentiality agreements and a breach of this agreement would result in the employee's termination.

While we take all reasonable precautions to ensure that user data is secure and that users are protected, there always remains the risk of harm. The internet as a whole can be insecure at times and, therefore, we are unable to guarantee the security of user data beyond what is reasonably practical.
